PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

Players may only play for one team during the course of Netfest.

Transgender Player Policy— must provide a Birth Certificate. A certified copy must be provided and an original must be provided upon request.

AGE GRADES

- Players competing in the Over 40 Masters Mixed Grade must be 40 years of age or over as at the 26th of March 2021.
- Players competing in the Over 50 Evergreens Mixed Grade must be 50 years of age or over as at the 26th of March 2021.

Any team found to be using illegal players will have all matches played as of that time, recorded as a default loss.

MATCH RULES

- All games will be played in accordance with the **Official Rules for Six A Side. The Indoor Netball Rulebook** for Netfest will be provided with the draw.
- All games, including Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Grand Finals will consist of four eight (8) minute quarters.
- The official ball for Netfest will be the Mikasa FX-5.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

- Each team can register a total of twelve (12) players during the course of Netfest, and each team must register their players at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of their first Netfest game.
- The names originally registered cannot be altered or extended in any form and only those players registered prior to the commencement of their team's first game will be eligible to play in Netfest.
- Teams can use any or all of their twelve (12) players per game. All players used in each game must be ticked off on the score sheet at the court prior to taking the court.
- In the case of mixed teams, no more than six (6) players of either sex may be used in any one game.

SCHEDULED START TIMES

- All teams must be present at the venue for their game at least fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled start time for each of their games.
- The official time for each game will commence at the scheduled start time, unless this is not possible due to delays caused through stoppages in play. In this instance, the official time will start at the discretion of the Tournament Convener's.

UMPIRES

- All matches inclusive of Quarter finals, Semi finals and Finals shall be adjudicated by one umpire.

SCORERS

- Each team must provide one person to act as a scorer for each match that they play. Of these two people, one will be responsible for keeping a manual record of the game and the second will be responsible for operating the remote control for the electronic score board.

PLAYING EQUIPMENT

- All teams must ensure that they provide their own practice balls, bibs and team uniform. A hireage fee of \$100 will be charged for 1 x set of bibs and upon returning the full set at the end of the tournament, \$80.00 will be refunded.

PROTEST COMMITTEES

- If required, the Netfest co-ordinator/s will convene a protest committee to hear and adjudicate on any protest lodged during Netfest.
- All protests must be made in writing and accompanied with a \$50.00 Protest Fee, by either the Team Captain or Team Manager.
- If the protest being lodged is in relation to a particular match played during Netfest, such protest must be made within sixty (60) minutes of that match finishing.
The protest committee will comprise of the Netfest Co-Ordinator and two other Team Representatives that are independent of any teams that may be involved in the protest.
- The decision of the Protest Committee will be deemed final and is not subject to appeal.

POINTS SCORING SYSTEM

- The following points will be allocated in each non-elimination match played during Netfest:

Win 4 Points	Default Win 8 Points
Draw 2 Points	Default Loss -8 Points
Loss 0 Points	
- In Addition to the above points, the team scoring the most goals in each quarter of each game will receive one (1) quad point.
- If the goals scored by each team during a quarter are the same, the quad point will carry forward and be awarded to the team that scores the most goals in the following quarter.
- In the instance where the goals scored in the last quarter of any match are tied, the quad point for that quarter will be awarded to the team that was most recently awarded with a quad point during that match. (In most cases this is the team that scored the most points in the third quarter).

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Foul and abusive language or behavior will not be tolerated at any stage of Netfest, and any Player, Official, Supporter or Spectator who acts in such a manner will be removed from both the venue and Netfest.

SMOKEFREE

- Smoking is not permitted anywhere within any of the stadiums being used to host this event.

LICENSED PREMISES

- Both hosting Venues and carpark areas are fully licensed and alcohol is not permitted to be carried in or out of these venues/carparks at any time. Each venue reserves the right to inspect water bottles or any other such vessel that may contain alcohol.
- Any person found breaking this condition of entry into the venue will be asked to leave the venue and further action may be taken.

TROPHIES AND AWARDS

- The winners of each grade will be presented with a set of twelve (12) gold medallions and twelve (12) Winners shirts.
- The runners up in each grade will be presented with a set of twelve (12) silver medallions.
